BAT Rules of Conduct for Swimmers and Parents

Belmont Aquatic Team (BAT) swimmers are part of a team and are expected to behave in a respectful fashion with coaches, fellow swimmers and team parents. In situations where a swimmer consistently exhibits a pattern of disruptive, disrespectful or unsafe behavior despite coach intervention, the Team reserves the right to suspend or expel a child from swim practices or the entire program. The Team makes every attempt to avoid having to ask a swimmer to leave, however, the following circumstances, among others, may be grounds for expulsion:

- Continued unsafe or dangerous behavior that puts any swimmer at risk.
- Consistent disruption to the functioning of the team at practices or meets.
- Continuous disrespectful behavior to coaches, swimmers or parents including the teasing or bullying of another swimmer.

Swimmers' Rules of Conduct:

- Swimmers must consistently display respect, honesty and sportsmanship toward coaches, teammates, officials, volunteers, parents and competitors.
- Swimmers are never to interfere with the progress of another teammate during practice or otherwise.
- Swimmers are required to wear proper team attire (team suit and cap) at all swim meets.
- Swimmers are expected to exhibit appropriate team behavior both at the pool and elsewhere during all swim meets.
- Swimmers must consistently display a positive and supportive attitude toward all teams, coaches, teammates and competitors.
- Parents will be notified if there is a discipline problem with their child, and a "three strikes" policy will be enforced.

Parents Rules of Conduct:

- You are expected to fulfill your volunteer obligations willingly, knowing that the effort put forth will directly impact your swimmer's experience.
- Certain meets (including the BAT sponsored meet at Wheaton College, and the Regional and Age Group Championships) require parent participation. Failure to fulfill your volunteer obligations places an increased burden on other parents. ***Repeated failure to fulfill your volunteer obligations will result in expulsion of your swimmer(s) from the team without a refund of tuition.***
- Although competition is a natural part of sports activities, you should not make winning the primary goal for you or your child.
- Support your child and his/her team in a positive manner. Cheer for your child and his/her team, not against the opposing player or team.
- All members of the club, whether parents or swimmers protect and improve the reputation of the team.
- Always show respect for all players, coaches, meet officials and other fans. Allow for the fact that anyone can make a mistake. Set a positive example for our children with your behavior.
